HOME WEATHERIZATION PROGRAM

What is Home Weatherization?

Home weatherization is for individuals and families who meet income guidelines. Measures are taken to make your home more energy-efficient, thereby saving on utility costs, increasing the value of the home and improving the safety of the occupants.

This program is designed to increase the energy efficiency of homes and thereby reduce energy costs.

Why Should Homes Be Weatherized?

- Weatherize homes are warmer in the winter and cooler in the summer.
- Program participants can reduce energy costs \$300-\$400/yr on average
- Weatherized homes add comfort and safety
- Energy costs are a burden on low-income households

Weatherizing Can Include:

- Insulation of attics, walls and floors
- Furnace repair
- Weather Stripped
- Window caulking
- Repair/replace windows
- Other minor home repairs

Who Qualifies For Weatherization?

Individuals and families in Boston, MA that meet income guidelines can qualify for this free program. Once eligibility is established, MOER Green Team will pair a licensed contractor with the home to install needed weatherization measures.

The weatherization crew will also address health and safety conditions including carbon monoxide and combustion safety.

Steps To Follow:

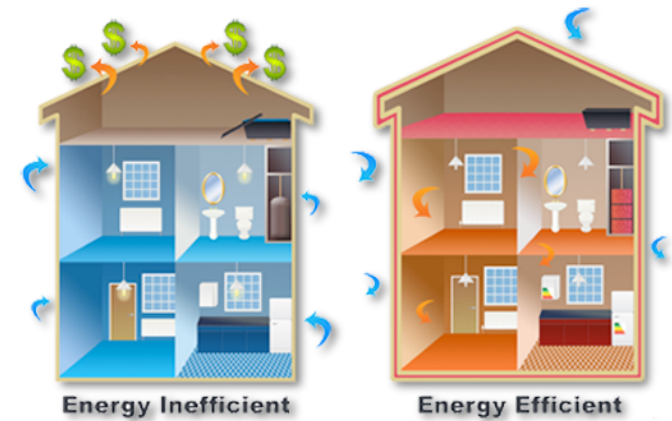

Following an interview with an Assessment and Eligibility Specialist, a certified inspector will be sent to the home to perform an energy audit. The inspector will determine what steps should be taken to weatherize the home.

Participants of the program will be offered to attend an energy savings program.

What To Bring To Your Appointment:

- Proof of income for all applicant (no working adults in the residence photocopies)
- Gas/heat bill with account number
- Proof of household size
- Electric bill with account number
- Photo ID and social security card of



MEASURES TO SAVE MONEY

- Install rubber gaskets behind outlets and switch plates
- Lower the thermostat on your hot-water heater
- Wash only full loads laundry
- Caulk, seal and weatherstrip all seams, cracks and openings
- Turn off lights in rooms you are not using.
- Use compact fluorescents light bulbs
